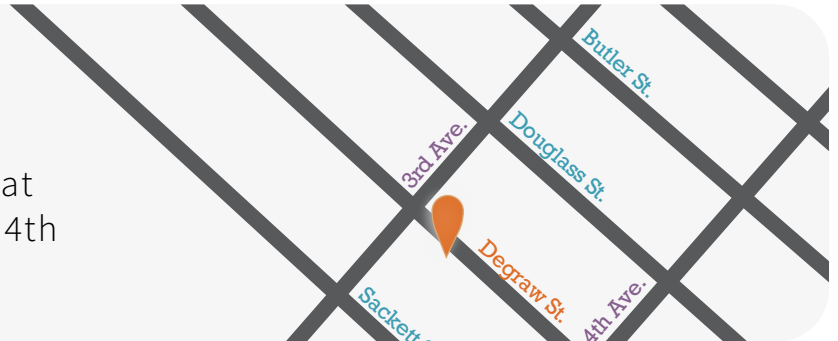


PRICING AND OTHER FAQs

Location

All lessons and classes take place at **600 Degraw St.**, between 3rd and 4th Avenues, first floor.



Tuition & Billing

Brooklyn Music Factory charges an annual tuition for the 10-month school year. The tuition amount is calculated based on every student receiving 34 band classes or private lessons between September and June. Annual tuition includes:

- ★ 34 lessons or classes per school year
- ★ 1 makeup lesson per school year (private lessons only)
- ★ On-site gigs
- ★ Recording opportunities
- ★ Reduced or free admission to special BMF workshops and performances

An additional \$4.95 per student is billed monthly to cover materials, including Big Music Games, lesson books, etc.

There are three options to pay the tuition:

- 1) Monthly installments from September 1-June 1
- 2) Two installments due on September 1 and February 1 (5% discount off full tuition)
- 3) One installment due on September 1 (5% discount off full tuition)

All tuition payments will be charged to the credit card on file.

TUITION RATES

Private Lessons

- 60 minute - \$3,400 (10-month school year)
- 45 minute - \$2,890 (10-month school year)
- 30 minute - \$2,100 (10-month school year)

Little Songwriters - \$450 (per semester)

MiniKeys - \$695 (per semester)

Club Keyboard - \$1,390 (10-month school year)

Jam Band, Rock Write Record 1 & GirlPop 1 Bands - \$1,480 (10-month school year)

Rock Write Record 2 & GirlPop 2 Bands - \$1,990 (10-month school year)

SongLab - \$990 (10-month school year)

Adult Bands - \$1,750 (10-month school year)

A one-time **\$40 membership fee** per student is due upon registration.

\$35 Missed Payment Fee

If a payment is late, a \$35 missed payment fee will be applied after 7 days. Classes and lessons can be paused due to non-payment.

A 5% discount will be applied for any student and/or family enrolled in more than one class or lesson!

Makeup Policy

Students enrolled in private lessons are entitled to one makeup lesson per year. Makeup lessons are held at the same day and time as your regular lesson during the designated makeup week in June. (If you are not owed a makeup lesson, you will not have a lesson during the makeup week.) If you need to miss a lesson, please tell your teacher at least 24 hours in advance.

There are no makeup classes for bands.

In cases of inclement weather, Brooklyn Music Factory follows the New York City public schools and will close if schools close. There are no refunds or makeups for classes and lessons missed due to inclement weather.

Cancellation Policy

BMF requires 30 days advance notice of cancellation for band or private lesson enrollment, which allows us to fill the spot. Once notice is given, your remaining tuition is prorated accordingly. For example: John Q. Rockstar's invoice is paid on the 1st of every month. He cancels on October 15. He then receives 4 more weeks of lessons and his November invoice is prorated 50%.

Please note: If stopping midyear, band students are strongly encouraged to commit through the band gig in January. All bands perform during the gig and the bands work hard in preparation. It's difficult for the whole band when a member is not able to play.
